Mr. Muhammad Afzal Jagirani, Advocate a/w petitioner. Mr. Munawar Ali Abbasi, Assistant A.G a/w SIP Mushtaq Ahmed, SHO, PS Waris Dino Machi and SIP Ali Dino on behalf of SSP Larkana.

Learned Assistant Advocate General has filed comments on behalf of respondents No.3, 5 and 7, which are taken on record. Copies thereof have been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Mr. Ghulam Muhammad Barejo, learned Advocate, files vakalatnama on behalf of respondent No.9 along with a statement and certain documents; the same are also taken on record and copies thereof have been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the official respondents, at the instance of private respondents, have been causing harassment to the petitioner, therefore the present petition has been filed seeking protection in accordance with law.

Conversely, learned Assistant Advocate General submits that the official respondents are duty-bound to act strictly in accordance with law and have already stated in their comments that they neither have harassed the petitioner nor do they intend to do so in future, and that they shall provide protection to him, if required, under the law.

Learned counsel representing respondent No.9 also submits that although a civil suit between the parties is pending adjudication, the answering respondent has not caused any harassment to the petitioner nor does he intend to do so in future.

After perusal of the statements filed by the official respondents as well as the statement filed on behalf of respondent No.9, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if the present petition is disposed of with directions for protection in accordance with law.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of with directions to the official respondents as well as respondent No.9 to act strictly in accordance with law and ensure that no harassment is caused to the petitioner. The official respondents are further directed to provide protection to the petitioner as and when required, strictly in accordance with law. This order, however, shall not prejudice or affect any civil proceedings pending between the parties, which shall be decided on their own merits in accordance with law.

Let a copy of this order be transmitted to the learned Additional Advocate General, Sindh as well as to the concerned official respondents for information and compliance.
