Learned Assistant Advocate General files statements/comments on behalf of respondents No.2 to 5, which are taken on record. Copies thereof have been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner. Mr. Imran Hyder Soomro, learned Advocate, files vakalatnama on behalf of respondents No.6 to 8, which is also taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that although the petitioner is willing to pay the admitted outstanding amount, the official respondents, allegedly at the behest of the private respondents, have been causing harassment to him; hence, the present petition has been filed seeking protection in accordance with law.

Conversely, learned Assistant Advocate General submits that the official respondents are duty-bound to act strictly in accordance with law, and as reflected from their comments, they neither have harassed the petitioner nor intend to do so in future. He further submits that the official respondents shall provide protection to the petitioner, if required, strictly in accordance with law.

Learned counsel appearing for private respondents No.6 to 8 contends that a substantial amount is outstanding against the petitioner, but he is not willing to clear the same. However, he submits that the answering respondents shall file proper proceedings before the competent forum having jurisdiction for recovery of such amount. He further states that the private respondents have not caused any harassment to the petitioner nor do they intend to do so in future.

After examining the statements filed by the official respondents, as well as the submissions made by learned counsel for respondents No.6 to 8, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if the petition is disposed of with directions for protection strictly in accordance with law.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of with directions to the official respondents as well as respondents No.6 to 8 to act strictly in accordance with law and to ensure that no harassment is caused to the petitioner. The official respondents shall further ensure that protection is provided to the petitioner, as and when required, strictly in accordance with law. The private respondents shall remain at liberty to initiate appropriate proceedings for recovery of their outstanding amount before the competent forum having jurisdiction.

Let a copy of this order be transmitted to the learned Additional Advocate General, Sindh, as well as to the concerned official respondents for information and compliance.
