The official respondents have filed their statements/comments through the learned A.A.G, which are taken on record. Copies thereof have been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who, after going through the same, submits that the FIRs shown to have been registered against the petitioner's son are managed by the official respondents. He further submits that in all such FIRs, the petitioner's son has already been admitted to bail and is facing trial before the competent Court. However, learned counsel contends that the official respondents must be restrained from acting illegally or in excess of their authority.

Conversely, learned A.A.G submits that the FIRs have been lawfully registered against the petitioner's son and that the present petition has been filed merely to shield him from the consequences of his acts. He clarifies that the police officials are bound to act strictly in accordance with law and shall refrain from taking any action that is contrary to law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, after examining the statements, submits that he would be satisfied if the instant petition is disposed of with directions ensuring that no harassment is caused to the petitioner and that protection is provided strictly in accordance with law.

Accordingly, the petition is disposed of with directions to the official respondents to act strictly in accordance with law and to ensure that no harassment is caused to the petitioner. The official respondents are further directed to provide protection to the petitioner, as and when required, strictly in accordance with law. However, if any FIR has been registered against the petitioner, he shall face the trial proceedings before the competent Court in accordance with law.

Let a copy of this order be transmitted to the concerned official respondents as well as to the learned Additional Advocate General, Sindh, for information and compliance.
