Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1, Ms. Kaveeta, has contracted a free-will marriage with petitioner No.2, Sham, of her own choice and consent. An affidavit affirming this free-will marriage has been filed along with the petition (pages 15–19). He further states that due to this unceremonious marriage, the mother of petitioner No.1, Ms. Ganga, impleaded as respondent No.4, became aggrieved and lodged FIR No.125/2025 at Police Station Town Mirpurkhas for offences under Sections 365-B PPC and Section 3(2) of the T.I.P. Act, 2018. The statement of petitioner No.1 was recorded on the very same day, i.e., 29.10.2025, after which notice was issued to the respondents.

Learned A.A.G. Sindh submits that the petitioners are not present today; therefore, no further statement of petitioner No.1 can be recorded. However, he states that since the contention of the petitioner has already been recorded by this Court, as noted above, the present petition may be disposed of accordingly. He further submits that in the meantime, the Investigating Officer may be directed to place the statement of the lady petitioner recorded by this Court on the very date before the

concerned Magistrate for disposal of the case under C Class. The request seems to be reasonable and acceded to.

The petition is disposed of in the above terms.

Let a copy of the order dated 29.10.2025, passed by this Court, be communicated to the concerned Magistrate for compliance.
