Mr. Sajid Hussain Mahesar, advocate files his Vakalatnama on behalf of the respondent No.8, taken on record. He files statement along with Ultra Sound report, same is also taken on record.

Official respondents No.1 to 4, file their respective statements, which are taken on record.

Mr. Shar counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioner No.1, was earlier married to respondent No.8 and out of said wedlock she had given birth to six children and later on due to matrimonial affairs as well as unwarranted behavior of the respondent No.8, respondent No.8 has divorced to petitioner No.1. Hence the petitioner No.1 has entered into second Nikah with petitioner No.2 and on such marriage, respondent has been annoying, therefore, the petitioners apprehend imminent danger to their lives, hence counsel submits that the official respondents may be directed to provide legal protection to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the respondent No.8 submits that the respondent No.8 has not divorced the petitioner No.1 as the petitioner No.1 is pregnant and such act on the part of petitioner No.1 tantamount to an offence and this petition in such circumstances may be dismissed.

Learned Asstt. A. G present in Court submits that they would direct the respondents to provide legal protection to the petitioners as and when they may approach to them strictly in accordance with law.

Since the petitioners have prayed only for legal protection against the harassment being caused to them by the private respondents through official respondents for which law officer assisted by the official respondents present in Court in their respective statements disclosed that they will act in accordance with law and will provide legal protection to the petitioners as and when needed. As far as submission of learned counsel for respondent No.8 that the respondent No.8 has not divorced the petitioner No.1 as the petitioner No.1 is pregnant is concerned, in this regard respondent No.8 is at liberty to file proper application/suit before proper forum, if so advised. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with direction to official respondents to provide legal protection to the petitioners in accordance with law.
