The respondents No.7, 8, 11 & 16 have appeared pursuant to process. The respondent No.7 Deedar Ali Solangi, who is the father of petitioner No.1 Mst. Faryal, submits that she had left his house without intimation and then she approached to them by phone; however, her in-laws had asked him for reconciliation but they did not approach him again instead maintained instant petition. As far alleged harassment is concerned, the respondent No.7, who is the father of petitioner No.1, categorically denies to have caused any kind of harassment to the petitioner, with an undertaking that he will not cause harassment to the petitioners in future as well; hence, prays for disposal of the petition.

As far harassment is concerned, statements have been filed on behalf of official respondents No.1, 2, 4 & 5, where they have denied to have caused any kind of harassment to the petitioners at the behest of private respondents and have further undertaken to provide due protection to the petitioners on their approach to them. The learned AAG as well as learned Addl. P.G. also submit that the official respondents shall act strictly in accordance with law.

In view of above statements of the police officials as well as learned law officer, the learned Counsel for the petitioners is satisfied and seeks disposal of the petition. Order accordingly. The officials respondents shall not cause harassment to the petitioner and shall provide them protection, as and when approached.
