O R D E R

Shamsuddin Abbasi, J:- Through this Criminal Revision Application, the applicant has impugned order dated 13.10.2025, whereby his application filed under section 516-A Cr.P.C for restoration of vehicle i.e. Dumper Truck bearing registration No.TAK-324, Model-2012, Engine No.JHDSH1EERXXX-10137, Chassis No.P11C-TE-12324, being case property of FIR No. 108 of 2025 for offence under sections 320, 322, 337-G, 279, 427 PPC of PS Digri, was dismissed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge-I, Mirpurkhas vide order dated 13.10.2025.

2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that applicant is registered owner of Dumper Truck in question. He further submits that said vehicle is lying idle at the police station and its continued seizer at police station would serve no useful purpose, which caused damages to the truck and applicant would suffer irreparable loss.

3. On the other hand, learned Additional Prosecutor General for the State has supported the impugned order.

4. Heard and perused the record.

5. Admittedly, the applicant is the owner of the dumper truck in question. The learned counsel for the applicant has produced certified copy of the report issued by the Senior Excise, Taxation and Anti-Narcotics Officer-I/ Motor Registration Authority, Lasbela District at Hub which clearly reflects that the dumper truck in question is registered in the name of Arshad Khan, the applicant. Dumper requires proper maintenance, which is not possible at police station. Even otherwise the applicant would suffer financial loss if it is seized at police station.

6. In view of the above, instant Criminal Revision Application is allowed. The dumper truck bearing Registration No.TAK-324, Model-2012, Engine No.JHDSH1EERXXX-10137, Chassis No.P11C-TE-12324 be released in favour of the applicant subject to furnishing solvent surety in the sum of Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lacs only) and P.R Bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of learned trial court with direction that the applicant shall not sell, transfer, or change the identity of the vehicle in any manner and shall produce the same before the learned trial Court as and when required.
