O R D E R

Muhammad Iqbal Kalhoro, J:- Applicant is seeking post arrest bail in a case bearing Crime No.302/2025, registered at Police Station Bin Qasim, Karachi, u/s 6/9(i)3(b) CNS (Amendment) Act, by means of this application.

2. Applicant was arrested on 29.07.2025 by a police team of Police Station Bin Qasim, from Aisha Steel Mills, Chowrangi Road, Bin Qasim, District Malir, Karachi, and from him allegedly 550 grams of charas was recovered. Hence, he was booked in the present case.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant has pleaded for bail on the ground that the alleged offence does not fall within the prohibitory clause u/s 497 Cr. PC; the challan has been submitted and the applicant is no more required for further investigation.

4. Learned Additional PG Sindh has opposed bail, citing the previous criminal record of the applicant; however, learned defence counsel has submitted judgments in all the cases in which applicant was previously booked showing that he has been acquitted. In view of the above facts as well as the fact that the alleged offence does not fall within the prohibitory clause u/s 497 Cr. PC, and applicant is no more required for further investigation. Accordingly, this application is allowed and applicant is granted bail subject to his furnishing a solvent surety in the sum of Rs.50,000/ (Rupees fifty thousand only) with P.R. bond in the like amount to be executed to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

5. Bail application stands disposed of in the above terms. The observations made hereinabove are tentative in nature and would not prejudice case of either party at trial.
