Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant claims the suit property solely on the basis of possession and does not possess any title document except the relevant entry recorded in the revenue record. Admittedly, a possession certificate or a revenue entry does not constitute a title document, and a declaration of ownership cannot be granted merely on the basis of such entry in the absence of any valid title document.

A perusal of the impugned judgments passed by the learned Courts below reflects that the matter has been duly considered on the basis of the available evidence and the settled principles of law. The findings recorded by the learned Courts below appear to be well-reasoned and based upon proper appreciation of the material available on record.

It is settled law that the revisional jurisdiction of this Court under Section 115, C.P.C. is limited in scope and can only be exercised where the subordinate Court has exercised jurisdiction not vested in it by law, has failed to exercise jurisdiction so vested, or has acted in the exercise of its jurisdiction with material illegality or irregularity. The applicant has not been able to point out any such jurisdictional defect, illegality, or material irregularity in the

impugned judgments warranting interference by this Court in exercise of its revisional jurisdiction.

In view of the above, this Court finds no jurisdictional error, illegality, or material irregularity in the impugned judgments passed by the learned Courts below. Consequently, the instant Civil Revision Application is dismissed in limine, along with the listed applications.
