ORDER

Adnan-ul-Karim Memon, J. – Petitioner Muhammad Akhtar has filed these Constitution Petitions under Article 199 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973, seeking following relief:-

1. *Direct the Respondents to forthwith release and pay all outstanding retirement/pensionary benefits and service dues of the Petitioner, including but not limited to arrears of pension from the due date (i.e., from retirement 09.12.2023), gratuity, commutation (if applicable), GPF/deductions and all other admissible dues;*
2. *Direct the Respondents to ensure continuity of monthly pension without further delay and to clear all arrears w.e.f. 01-07-2025 till 01-10-205 and up to date;*
3. *Call for the record pertaining to the Petitioner's pension/retirement case, including movement sheets, objections (if any), and status of processing, and to fix responsibility for unlawful delay;*
4. *Grant any other equitable relief deemed just and proper in the circumstances.*

2. It appears that the petitioner was appointed as Head Malhi in 1984 and retired from municipal service in 2023, but his pensionary benefits have not yet been released.

3. Learned counsel for Respondent-KMC submits that the petitioner's claim was received by the Welfare Department, KMC on 17.06.2025 and his case for payment of Rs.2,064,901 has been processed, which shall be paid within three weeks.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks disposal of the petition in terms of the statement made by counsel for Respondent-KMC.

5. Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of along with all pending applications in the above terms.
