ORDER

Adnan-ul-Karim Memon, J Petitioner Anas, son of Muhammad Yousuf, has filed this Constitutional Petition under Article 199 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973, seeking the following relief: -

“a) Declare that the act of placing the CNIC No- 42501-2466652-3/Data of the Petitioner by the Respondents under suspicion without justification is illegal, unlawful and violative of constitutional rights.

b) Direct the Respondents to restore and clear the CNIC No- 42501-2466652-3/Data of the Petitioner permanently and issue confirmation accordingly.

c) Restraining the Respondents from taking any adverse action against the petitioner without due course of law.

2. Today, learned counsel for NADRA submitted that according to the records and comments of the Verification & Revocation Branch, the petitioner’s CNIC was temporarily cleared in 2017 but was subsequently re-impounded due to the petitioner’s non-appearance before the Verification Board. The matter is currently pending before the Zonal Verification Board, Zone C, Malir, for verification, vide Board ID No. Z030C0012610. Therefore, the petitioner is required to personally appear before the Zonal Verification Board, Zone C, Malir, Karachi, along with all original documents prior to 1979 and one Alpha family member, for reevaluation of the case.

3. Since the petitioner is not present today, we deem it appropriate to dispose of the petition with the above directions.

An intimation notice shall be issued to the petitioner to comply with these directions. This Order shall also be communicated to the relevant NADRA authorities.
