The following issue had been proposed for determination:

“Whether in view of the facts and circumstances of the case, the learned Appellate Tribunal has not erred in law to reduce redemption fine, imposed by the original authority in terms of SRO 499(I)/2009 dated 13.06.2009, issued under the provisions of Section 181 of the Customs Act, 1969?”

Learned counsel placed courier receipt on record to demonstrate that service has been effected. Learned counsel states that the quantum of redemption fine is as prescribed and any deviation therefrom is prima facie unsustainable. Learned counsel states that it is the said deviation that has led to the present references and the same has not been justified by the learned Tribunal. He states that it could be in the interest of justice and revenue if to the extent as aforesaid the judgment is set aside and the matters are remanded back to the learned Tribunal for adjudication afresh in accordance with law.
