These reference applications have been pending since 2023 without any significant progress even notices have not been issued. Paragraph 6 of the impugned common judgment reads as follows:

“6. Under the provision of Section 194-A(1)(a) of the Customs Act, 1969 this Tribunal has no jurisdiction to proceed and decide the instant appeals, wherein, the impugned Orders-in-Original have been passed by the officer of Customs below the rank of Additional Collector u/s 179 of the Customs Act, 1969.”

Learned counsel remains unable to displace or distinguish the observation recorded and merely seeks time. Respectfully, matter having clogged the docket without any progress for three years. Accordingly, in view of judgment of CIR vs. Rafeh Limited reported in PLD 2020 SC 518, these reference applications are dismissed for non-prosecution along with pending application(s).
