Learned Addl. A.G. files compliance report dated 16.04.2026 along with set of documents on behalf of alleged contemnor No.2 Local Government & HTP Department, taken on record, hands over its copy to learned counsel for the petitioner, who after going through the same seeks disposal of petition. Before parting with the order, it will be appropriate to reproduce the contents of such compliance report, which reads as under:

“In compliance with the orders dated 31.10.2026 passed by the Honorable High Court, it is most respectfully submitted as under:

- i. That a meeting was convened in the office of the Chief Secretary, Sindh, to deliberate upon the grant of proforma promotion to the Petitioner with effect from his date of retirement, i.e., 31.10.2023, along with all consequential pensionary benefits.
- ii . That, pursuant to the decision conveyed by the Section Officer-III. Services, General Administration and Coordination Department, vide letter dated 07.04.2026 (Annexure-A), the matter, however, was taken up forthwith upon due communication and placement on record. The ease has since been placed before the Sindh Local Government Board, which, after due deliberation, has resolved to allow retirement to the petitioner in BS-20 for pensionary benefits only, subject to approval of the Competent Authority.
- iii. That, in terms of Rule 8 of the Sindh Civil Servants (SCUG) Service Rules, 2020, the Chief Minister, Sindh, is the Competent Authority in such cases. The matter is accordingly forwarded for necessary action to obtain requisite approval (Annexure-B).

2 In view of the foregoing, this Compliance Report is submitted for the kind perusal of the Hon'ble High Court of Sindh.

3. It is, therefore, most respectfully prayed that the contempt proceedings may kindly be disposed of in the interest of justice.”

Accordingly, in view of the above, this application is hereby disposed of, however, the competent authority / Chief Minister Sindh shall notify the proforma promotion of the petitioner under intimation to this Court through learned MIT-II within a period of three months. A copy of this order shall be sent by fax to the Principal Secretary, Chief Minister Sindh and the Chief Secretary, Government of Sindh for compliance. Learned Addl. A.G. claims a copy of the order for correspondence and compliance. Order accordingly. Learned MIT-II to ensure compliance.
