Mr. Mohsin Ali Khan, Asstt. A. G a/w I.O of Crime No.267/2026 of PS Korangi Karachi under section 364-A, PPC and 3 TIP Act, 2013.

Mr. Iltaf Hussain Khokhar, advocate files his Vakalatnama on behalf of private Respondents No.8, 9 & 11, taken on record.

Official respondents No.3, 4 & 6 file their statements, taken on record. Both the petitioners are present. I.O of Crime No. 267/2026 of PS Korangi Karachi under section 364-A, PPC and 3 TIP Act, 2013 is also present and has recorded the statement of petitioner No.1 Mst. Rehana and has placed it's copy on record. The petitioner No.1 has stated in her statement recorded before the I.O that she has not been abducted by any one and she out of her free-will has contracted marriage with petitioner No.2 Sarmand without any coercion and compulsion. She has further stated in her statement that FIR lodged against her husband is false and baseless.

Mr. Iltaf Hussain Khokhar, advocate for private Respondents No.8, 9 & 11, submit that the petitioner No.2, who is relative of private respondents came at their house and got permission of petitioner No.1 and her sister to visit his house and thereafter, the petitioner No.2 has contracted marriage with petitioner No.1, while the sister of petitioner No.1, is still missing and by doing so, the petitioner No.2, has committed the offence.

The I.O present submits that in view of Nikahnama, affidavit of freewill and the statement recorded under section 161, Cr.P.C, he will submit the requisite report u/s 173, Cr.P.C before the concerned Court within 15 days, in accordance with law. The concerned Magistrate is

directed to pass appropriate orders by considering all the material placed before him by the I.O of the case.

In view of above, learned Counsel for the petitioners being satisfied seeks disposal of the petition with direction to the official respondents to provide protection to the petitioners in accordance with law. Learned Asstt. A. G has no objection Order accordingly. However, private respondents are at liberty to seek remedy by initiating appropriate proceedings against the petitioner No.2 in accordance with law.

Instant petition stands disposed of in the terms stated above.
