Mr. Mohsin Ali Khan, Asstt. A. G a/w I.O of Crime No.49/2026 of PS Radhan under section 365-B, PPC.

Mr. Sajid Hussain Mahesar, advocate files his Vakalatnama on behalf of private Respondents No.7 to 10, taken on record.

Official respondents No.3 to 6 file their reports, taken on record. Both the petitioners are present. I.O of Crime No. 49/2026 of PS Radhan under section 365-B, PPC is also present and has recorded the statement of petitioner No.1 Mst. Zar Khatoon and has placed it's copy on record. The petitioner No.1 has stated in her statement recorded before the I.O that she has not been abducted by any one and she out of her free-will has contracted marriage with petitioner No.2 Amanullah without any coercion and compulsion. She has further stated in her statement that FIR lodged against her husband is false and baseless.

Mr. Sajid Hussain Mahesar, advocate for the private respondents submit that Mst.Zar Khatoon is already married with one Mumtaz and she without getting "Talaq/Khula" from her earlier husband has contracted second marriage with petitioner No.2, which is against the injunctions of Islam.

The I.O present submits that in view of Nikahnama, affidavit of freewill and the statement recorded under section 161, Cr.P.C, he will submit the requisite report u/s 173, Cr.P.C before the concerned Court within 15 days, in accordance with law. The concerned Magistrate is directed to pass appropriate orders by considering all the material placed before him by the I.O of the case.

In view of above, learned Counsel for the petitioners being satisfied seeks disposal of the petition with direction to the official

respondents to provide protection to the petitioners in accordance with law. Learned Asstt. A. G has no objection Order accordingly. However, private respondents are at liberty to avail appropriate remedy before the proper forum in accordance with law.

Instant petition stands disposed of in the terms stated above.
