ORDER

ZULFIQAR ALI SANGI, J.- Through instant Criminal Bail Application applicants Ali Sher, Imran Ali, Salman alias Kamran, Rizwan Ali, Ramzan all by caste Mahar seek pre-arrest bail in Crime No.138 of 2026, registered at P.S, A-section, Sukkur, under sections 324, 506/2, 337A(i), 337F(i), 114, 147 & 148 PPC. Their earlier bail plea was declined by learned trial Court vide order dated 11.05.2026.

2. The facts of the F.I.R. are mentioned in the bail application copy whereof is also attached with the memo of bail application, hence, need not to reproduce the same here.

3. Counsel for applicants contends that applicants are innocent and have falsely been implicated in this case due to annoyance on matrimonial dispute; that the offence with which the applicants are charged do not fall within prohibitory clause of section 497 CrPC; whereas, ingredients of section 324 PPC do not attract in the present case and its applicability would be determined at the time of trial. Lastly, it is contended that both the parties have settled their dispute outside the Court, and the complainant has no objection if

the interim pre-arrest bail earlier granted to the applicants is confirmed.

4. Conversely, learned Deputy P.G. as well as complainant, present in Court, have conceded the request for confirmation of the interim pre-arrest bail on the ground that the matter has already been settled between the parties outside the Court.

5. The grounds so agitated by learned counsel for the applicants, coupled with the no objection raised by the complainant, entitle the applicants to the confirmation of the interim pre-arrest bail. Under these circumstances, this bail application is **allowed** and the interim pre-arrest bail earlier granted to the applicants by this Court vide order dated 18.05.2026 is hereby confirmed on the same terms and conditions.
