- 2&4. Applicant Raj Kumar son of Hira Lal seeks protective bail in Crime No. 7/2025 registered under sections 3,4, 8, 20, 21 and 22 of the AML Act, 2010 read with Section 33 (11) and (13) of the Sales Tax Act, 1990 by Directorate of Intelligence & Investigation, (Inland Revenue) Karachi.

Learned counsel submits that the Applicant has been served notice dated 03.04.2026 to appear before the Investigating Officer, however, from the contents of the impugned notice, it is not clear that the Applicant’s appearance is required as an accused or witness, as such he apprehends his imminent arrest at the hands of Investigating Officer. Let notice be issued to the Special Prosecutor Customs as well as DAG for 04.05.2026 to confirm whether Applicant Raj Kumar is required by Customs or not and whether they intend to arrest him or not. Till the next date he may not be arrested in this case.

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Tahir Zafar, Assistant Director/I.O. of the case is present and has confirmed that the Applicant Raj Kumar son of Hira Lal is required as an accused in Crime No. 7/2025 registered under sections 3,4, 8, 20, 21 and 22 of the AML Act, 2010 read with Section 33 (11) and (13) of the Sales Tax Act, 1990 and not as a witness and therefore notice was issued to him.

Accordingly, the applicant is granted seven (07) days protective bail subject to his furnishing surety in the sum of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) and P.R Bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Nazir of the Court. This order shall cease to have its effect on 10.05.2026 or when the applicants surrender before the concerned Court whichever is earlier.

Cr.Bail Application stands disposed of.
