ORDER

MUHAMMAD IQBAL KALHORO J: Applicants are seeking pre arrest bail in Crime No.147/2026, u/s 9(i)3(c) CNS, registered at Police Station SIU, Karachi. They are present on ad-interim pre arrest bail granted to them vide order dated 17.07.2026, and today the matter is fixed for confirmation or otherwise.

2. On spy information, a police team of Police Station SIU headed by SIP Syed Akbar Ali Shah reached the pointed place viz. Sindh Jamat Cooperative Housing Society, near National Highway, Shah Latif Town, Karachi, where they spotted three persons allegedly selling the narcotics. Out of them, co-accused Atta-ur-Rehman was arrested at the spot, whereas, the other two accused made their escape good, whose names were disclosed by him as Abdullah and Jamal Ahmed, the applicants. From arrested accused 2190 grams of charas was recovered, whereas, from the shopper bags allegedly thrown by the applicants, 2485 and 2460 grams of charas respectively were recovered. Hence, the present case.

3. Learned counsel for the applicants has pleaded for bail on the ground that applicants are innocent and have been falsely implicated in the case; there is no CDR record showing their presence at the spot and that they have been implicated on account of the video made viral by them on social media against the police for raiding their village.

4. Learned Addl: PG Sindh has opposed bail but he and the IO both have confirmed that *prima facie* there is no CDR record or any video or photo showing presence of the applicants at the spot as alleged. Hence, we are of the view that case against the applicants requires further inquiry. Then, their escape from the spot in presence of the police party also makes their case to be one of further inquiry. Consequently, this bail application is allowed and ad-interim pre-arrest bail granted to the applicants vide order dated 17.07.2025 is hereby confirmed on same terms and conditions.

5. Needless to mention that the observations made herein above are tentative in nature and would not prejudice case of either party at trial. The bail application is disposed of in the above terms.
