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ORDER

MUHAMMAD IQBAL KALHORO J: Applicant Muhammad Adil @ Muhammad Dadeen S/o Muhamad Akbar is seeking post arrest bail in Crime No 147, 148, 149, 353, 324, 302, 186, 395, 109, 427, 337-H(ii) PPC of P.S. Sohrab Goth, Karachi.

2. Applicant was on bail granted to him on merits by the trial Court in subject case but he remained absent before the trial court on 25.03.2026, 08.04.2026 and 08.05.2026 without intimation. Hence his bail was recalled and NBWs were issued against him. Later on, he surrendered in the trial Court on 15.05.2026 by moving an application for pre-arrest bail, which was rejected and he was taken into custody. Then he filed an application for post arrest bail, which has been dismissed through the impugned order.

3. Learned counsel has submitted that absence of the applicant before the Court was not deliberate or intentional but he had missed to record the dates of the case. Moreso, applicant was on bail since 2022 and had never misused the said concession. The case is still pending and there are 75 accused.

4. On the other hand learned Addl.P.G. has recorded a formal objection. We have considered submissions and are of the view that the applicant has been sufficiently punished. He is in jail since 15.05.2026 for absence of only two months. Moreso, the trial Court has failed to conclude the trial since 2022 and apparently the delay cannot be attributed to the applicant solely. We allow this application and grant bail to the applicant subject to his furnishing solvent surety in the sum of Rs.200,000/- and P.R. bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial court.

5. The observations made herein above are tentative in nature and would not prejudice case of either party at trial.

6. This Cr. Bail Applications is disposed of.
