None present for the petitioner, no intimation is furnished. However, from the perusal of the memo of the petition, it appears that the petitioner has called in question the bidding process (NIT) initiated by Respondent No.4, Chief Executive Engineer, Highways Division, Jacobabad and sought directions to decide his Review Appeal pending before the competent authority. Learned Assistant Advocate General, who is present in Court in connection with other matters, waives notice of the instant petition and submits that as per SPPRA Rules, 2010, the Chairman, Complaint Redressal Committee is the appropriate forum to decide the Review Appeal/Complaint of the petitioner.

This Court is not inclined to interfere in a matter where an adequate and efficacious alternate remedy is provided under the law, rules, regulations, or prescribed policies framed pursuant to legislation, and such remedy is available to the petitioner. In the instant case, two remedies are available to the petitioner under Rules 31 and 32 of Sindh Public Procurement Rules, 2010 for redressal of his grievance. Therefore, in the presence of such efficacious alternative remedies, this Court is not inclined to exercise its constitutional jurisdiction at this stage.

Accordingly, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to the Chairman, Complaint Redressal Committee, Sindh Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (SPPRA) to decide the Review Appeal/Complaint of the petitioner within a period of 15 days in accordance with law.
