ORDER

Adnan-ul-Karim Memon, J. Petitioner Arif Masih has filed this Constitutional Petition under Article 199 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973, with the following prayer: -

- A. *It is most respectfully prayed on behalf of the above named petitioner that this Court may be pleased to pass order to all the above named respondents for payment of all remaining dues / benefits, gratuity, provident fund, pensions, insurance etc., according to the service rules and regulations and other funds, as the petitioner is entitled to claim without further delay.*
- B. *To direct the respondents to pay Rs.817,492/-to the petitioner on account of aggrieved period of about 13 months from his retirement according to the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of Pakistan.*

2. It is, inter alia, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has retired from service on 27.1.2025 from the KMC, however, his pensionary benefits have not yet been released. Learned counsel for the KMC sought time to file comments on the premise that they had written a letter to the Regional Director (Karachi Division), Local Government Department for submission of pension cases and as the name of the petitioner appeared at Serial No.16 of the list of pensioners, who were / are required to be paid, however, nothing has been done.

3. Respondent No.6 / Director Sanitation, TMC Mauripur, District Keamari, Karachi is present in Court and submits that within two days' time the case of pensionary benefits of the petitioner shall be processed and the file of the petitioner shall be transmitted to the office of the KMC within that period, thereafter his pensionary benefits shall be released by the KMC.

4. Learned counsel for the KMC is of the same view.

5. In view of above statement, without touching the merits of the case and with the consent of the parties present in Court, this petition stands disposed of alongwith listed / pending application(s) with directions to Respondent No.6 / Director Sanitation, TMC Mauripur, District Keamari, Karachi to remit the pension file of the petitioner within two days' time and thereafter the case be processed and the pensionary benefits of the petitioner be released within three weeks' time.
