The Report submitted by SHO PS A-Section, Dadu is taken on record. As per information available on record in the two Criminal Jail Revisions, the applicant/convict Ayaz Ali s/o Ghulam Qadir Soomro has already served out his conviction and was released from prison on 15.08.2023 on completion of his sentence in the aforementioned Criminal Jail Revision Applications except that he was confined as UTP in other criminal cases and thus finally released from the prison on 30.07.2024. On 26.03.2026 this bench issued notice to the appellant at his address viz. Village Ismail Achra Taluka and District Dadu. Thereafter ASI Khalid Hussain Abro PS A-Section Dadu appeared and informed the Court that applicant/convict is not available at the given address. He submitted that the applicant has apparently ran away from his ancestral village. Accordingly, this explains the non-responsiveness on the part of the applicant-convict to the repeated notices sent to him to ascertain his intention as to whether he intends to proceed with the Criminal Jail Revisions which have failed to culminate into any positive response. Clearly, the bench cannot go on endlessly pursuing the applicant/convict. Based on his conduct, it appears that he has lost interest in pursuing the instant Criminal Jail Revision Applications. Further, the ASI's report suggests that he has shifted from his present address to some unknown place. Therefore, his appearance appears impossible in the near future. Finally, the complainant has placed on record

certain documents which reflect that the applicant/convict in other matters, one of which being FIR No.22/2025 registered at Phulji Police Station before the Civil Judge & Judicial Magistrate-III, Dadu, has been declared in the said criminal case as a proclaimed offender and the said case was last listed for hearing on 20.03.2026 before the trial Court and adjourned to 10.11.2026.

In the circumstances, as a consequence of continuous non-appearance of the appellant/convict, it appears that he has lost interest in pursuing the instant Criminal Jail Revision Applications. Therefore, the aforementioned two Criminal Jail Revision Applications have become infructuous and are dismissed accordingly.
