3. Exemption application is granted subject to all just exceptions.

The petitioner, an Office bearer of the Sindh Para Veterinary Staff Association is aggrieved of the election schedule issued by the Assistant Director (Trust) Regional Directorate of Industries & Commerce, Hyderabad acting as Election Commissioner in respect of said Association. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the order for holding election is unlawful for the reason that the tenure of the previous management has yet to expire. However from the election schedule it appears that the election is being held pursuant to an order dated 18.03.2026 passed by the Registrar Joint Stock Companies Karachi, which order has not been challenged by the petitioner. Nevertheless, the Sindh Para Veterinary Staff Association appears to be a Company registered under section 42 of the erstwhile Companies Ordinance 1984, which is not a Company controlled by the Government. Therefore any dispute with regards to election of such Company cannot be agitated by way of a writ petition. The petition is therefore dismissed in *limine* as not maintainable.
