Through this petition petitioner is seeking following relief(s):

“a. Declare that the actions, interference, threats and coercive conduct of Respondents No.5 and 6 in relation to the complaint submitted by Respondent No.7 are without lawful authority and of no legal effect;

b. Declare that Respondents No.5 and 6 have no lawful authority to adjudicate, determine, enforce or compel settlement of disputed employment claims, salary claims, service benefits or contractual obligations arising out of an employer-employee relationship;

c. Restrain Respondents No.5 and 6, their subordinates, agents, officials and all persons acting under their authority from harassing, intimidating, coercing, pressurizing or taking any adverse action against the Petitioner except strictly in accordance with law;

d. Direct Respondents No.1 to 4 to ensure that police machinery is not utilized for settlement, enforcement or recovery of disputed employment claims arising out of private contractual relationships;

e. Direct Respondents No.2, 3 and 4 to examine the conduct of Respondents No.5 and 6 in relation to the complaint submitted by Respondent No.7 and ensure that subordinate officers act strictly within the limits prescribed by law;

f. Direct that no coercive action, adverse proceedings, unlawful harassment or abuse of police powers shall be undertaken against the Petitioner on the basis of the complaints submitted by Respondent No.7 unless a cognizable offence is independently disclosed and due process of law is strictly followed;

g. Direct Respondents No.5 and 6 to decide the complaint strictly in accordance with law and to refrain from compelling settlement of disputed salary or employment claims through threat of criminal proceedings;

h. Grant any other relief deemed just, proper and equitable in the facts and circumstances of the case.

Mr. K.A. Vaswani, learned Assistant Advocate General, Sindh, submits that, in terms of the prayer clauses, he undertakes that the official respondents shall conduct themselves strictly in accordance with law and shall not cause any harassment to the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks disposal of the instant petition in view of the statement made by the learned Assistant Advocate General, Sindh. Order accordingly.

Before parting with the order, it is essential to clarify that this order shall not, in any manner, affect any employment-related issues being dealt with by the employer and is confined strictly to the alleged harassment being caused by the official respondents to the petitioner.

This petition stands disposed of in the above terms alongwith pending applications. A copy of this order shall be sent to SSP District (East) Karachi for compliance.
