ORDER

Adnan-ul-Karim Memon, J. Petitioner has filed this Constitutional Petition under Article 199 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973, seeking following relief: -

- a. Declare the failure of the respondents to prepare and issue duplicate service book of the petitioner as illegal, unlawful and without lawful authority;
- b. Direct the respondents to immediately reconstruct, prepare and issue the duplicate service book of the petitioner on the basis of available official record and service documents, and thereafter place and consider the petitioner's case before the competent Promotion Board/Committee strictly in accordance with law, seniority and eligibility, without subjecting him to any prejudice on account of delays or negligence attributable to the department.
- c. Direct the respondents to grant the petitioner all consequential service benefits including consideration for promotion from the date his juniors/batch mates were promoted, subject to law;
- d. Restrain the respondents from causing any further prejudice to the petitioner on account of loss of service record which occurred while the same remained in official custody;

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in terms of report submitted by the SSP Security-II Karachi, this petition needs to be disposed of as he has already received a duplicate service book of ASI.

In view of such statement and without touching the merits of the case, this petition stands disposed of in terms thereof.
