O R D E R
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MUHAMMAD IQBAL KALHORO J: Applicant was arrested by a police team of P.S. Boat Basin, Karachi on 20.03.2026 from Peela ground corner service road, Shireen Jinnah colony, Clifton, Karachi and allegedly from him, 1020 grams of Ice was recovered, hence he was booked in FIR bearing Cr. No.163/2026 U/s 6 (2), 9 CNS Act, 2024 of P.S. Boat Basin, Karachi.

2. Learned counsel for applicant has pleaded that applicant was arrested from his home, CCTV footage of which, he attempted to give to the I.O to show his innocence but he refused to entertain the same; applicant is first offender and the case has not yet been challaned despite lapse of statutory period of 14 days.

3. I.O. has been produced in response to NBWs and submits that he is living on rent and undergoing financial problems, hence he could not submit the Challan. Such explanation is bizarre, and on face of it illegal, yet learned Addl. P.G. has opposed grant of bail to applicant.

4. The trial has not commenced even after lapse of five months due to non-submission of the Challan in the court. The explanation forwarded in this regard by I.O. is alarming. The level of investigation is poor; as *prima facie* the evidence produced by accused of his arrest form a different place has been completely ignored. Hence, we allow this application and grant bail to the applicant subject to his furnishing a solvent surety in the sum of

Rs.200,000/- and P.R bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial court.

5. However, before parting with this order, we refer the matter of I.O. to DIG South, Karachi to look into his credentials to ascertain whether he is fit to be retained in police force or not.

The observations made hereinabove are tentative in nature and would not prejudice case of either party at trial.

The Cr. Bail Application is disposed of.
