ORDER

Adnan-ul-Karim Memon, J. Petitioner S.M. Kamran has filed the present Constitutional Petition under Article 199 of the Constitution.

At the outset, learned counsel for the respondent submitted that the matter is squarely covered by the judgment of the Honourable Supreme Court dated 10.07.2025, as well as the subsequent orders passed by this Court in C.P. No. D-5598 of 2018 and connected matters on 24.09.2025 and in C.P. No. D-6240 of 2020 on 20.10.2025.

Since the controversy raised in the present petition is identical to that already settled, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the matter pending or examining it afresh.

Moreover, the petitioner and the learned counsel for the petitioner are absent and have not assisted this Court in distinguishing the present case from the binding precedent. Accordingly, in view of the settled legal position and the petitioner's failure to prosecute the matter, the petition is dismissed in default.
