Mr. Mohsin Ali Khan, Assistant Advocate General, Sindh alongwith Mr. Khalid Hussain Mangrio, PDSP Legal Kashmore @ Kandhkot on behalf of AIG.P Establishment-II & AIGP Legal, and SIP Shafique Abro of Legal Branch.

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Mr. Khalid Hussain Mangrio, PDSP (Legal), Kashmore at Kandhkot, appearing on behalf of AIGP Establishment-II and AIGP Legal, has filed comments/report along with letter dated 07.09.2026 addressed to the Assistant Inspector General of Police, Legal-II, CPO Sindh, which are taken on record. The said letter reflects that the petitioner had appeared in the written test for the post in question conducted by Pakistan Testing Service (PTS); however, his written test result was cancelled by PTS on account of incorrect/improper filling of the bubble sheet, allegedly in violation of the prescribed SOPs of PTS. According to the respondents, the relevant instructions had been duly conveyed to the candidates through the admit card and bubble sheet as well as by the invigilation staff. It is further stated that the aforesaid position was communicated to the petitioner through DIGP, Larkana Range, with a request to inform him accordingly, vide office Letter No.10495-96/EB-III/T-7/S&S/2023 dated 22.05.2023.

The report further reflects that the second phase of recruitment against the Deceased Quota was initiated through a competitive process pursuant to advertisement dated 28.04.2024 under the Sindh Police (Shaheed, Deceased, Invalidated or Incapacitated Quota) Recruitment Rules, 2021. However, the said

recruitment process was subsequently stopped in view of the judgment passed by the Honourable Supreme Court of Pakistan in Civil Petition No.3390 of 2021.

It further transpires from the aforesaid letter that, pursuant to Notification No.SOR(1)(SGA&CD)2-25/2024(pt-f) dated 30.04.2026, issued by the Services, General Administration & Coordination Department (Regulation Wing), Government of Sindh, the Competent Authority has initiated a fresh recruitment process vide office letter dated 27.08.2026 and the advertisement issued in pursuance thereof. In these circumstances, the petitioner shall be at liberty to approach the Competent Authority by submitting a fresh application in accordance with the applicable rules, policy and the terms of the advertisement.

At this juncture, learned PDSP (Legal), Kashmore at Kandhkot, appearing on behalf of AIGP Establishment-II and AIGP Legal, undertakes before this Court that, upon submission of a fresh application, the case of the petitioner shall be considered on priority basis, strictly in accordance with law, rules and policy, keeping in view that he has been continuously pursuing his claim before the Department since the year 2021. The respondents shall remain bound by the undertaking so made before this Court.

In view of the above statement and undertaking, the grievance of the petitioner stands sufficiently addressed. Consequently, the instant petition is **disposed of** in the above terms.
