**ORDER**

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**Muhammad Iqbal Kalhoro, J:-** Applicant is seeking post arrest bail in a case bearing Crime No.207/2025, u/s 9(I) 3(c) of CNS Amendment Act, 2024, registered at Police Station Quaidabad, Karachi, by means of this application.

2. On 22.04.2025 applicant was arrested by a police team of Police Station Quaidabad, Malir, Karachi, headed by SIP Sajid Mehmood, from Star Ground near Mola Madad Qabarustan, Swati Mohalla Quaidabad, Malir, Karaachi, and from him allegedly 1030 grams of charas was recovered. Hence, he was booked in the present case.

3. Applicant's counsel has pleaded for bail on the ground that more than one year has passed, still the charge has not been framed; the applicant is first offender, and the compliance of Section 7(2) of Sindh Control of Narcotic Substances Act, 2024, has not been done.

4. On the other hand, learned Addl: PG Sindh has opposed bail.

5. We are of view that applicant is entitled to grant of bail on the ground that he is the first offender and *prima facie* compliance of Section 7(2) of Sindh Control of Narcotic Substances Act, 2024, has not been done. More so, more than one year has passed, but no tangible progress in the trial has been made for no fault of the applicant. Accordingly, this bail application is allowed and applicant is granted bail subject to his furnishing a solvent surety in the sum of Rs.100,000/ (Rupees one hundred thousand only) with P.R. bond in the like amount to be executed to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

6. Bail application stands disposed of in the above terms. The observations made hereinabove are tentative in nature and would not prejudice case of either party at trial.
