2-4. The Petitioner No.1 is a private limited company, whereas the Petitioner No.2 claims to be its majority shareholder and Chief Executive Officer. In that capacity, they seek to advance a host of convoluted prayers, most of which are directed towards Respondent No.2, itself a limited company, all of which flow from a contract dated 14.05.2014 entered into between the Petitioner No.1 and said Respondent following a public tender floated on 20.09.2013. As is discernible, the dispute relates to the performance obligations of the Petitioner No.1 under that contract and it transpires that steps have already been taken for referral of the matter to arbitration. Indeed, CP No. 2871 of 2026 was earlier filed by the Petitioner No.1, seeking that this Court exercise supervision over the arbitral proceedings, and was dismissed vide an Order dated 11.05.2026. Whilst the present Petition has been couched in such terms as to allude to elements of public importance, and the Petitioner No.2 has sought to emphasize such aspect during his submissions, on examination, we do not find to be the matter anything more than a contractual dispute, as aforementioned. The Petition is thus found to be misconceived and stands dismissed *in limine* accordingly along with the pending miscellaneous application.
