ORDER.

RIAZAT ALI SAHAR, J- It is, *inter alia*, contended by the learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners are tenants of the Municipal Committee, Kandhkot, in respect of certain municipal shops.

The Municipal Committee, Kandhkot, has issued notice dated 01.09.2026 (Annexure 'D', at page 63 of the petition), whereby the petitioners have been directed to vacate the possession of the said properties under the garb of the order dated 22.07.2026 passed by this Court at Larkana in C.P. No.D-17 of 2026. He further submits that there is, admittedly, a relationship of landlord and tenant between the petitioners and the official respondents, i.e., Municipal Committee, Kandhkot. He submits that if a direction is issued to the Municipal Committee, Kandhkot, that, without being influenced by the aforesaid order, the matter between the parties shall be dealt with and decided strictly in accordance with the applicable rules, laws and prescribed policies, the

petitioners would not press the instant petition and the same may accordingly be disposed of.

Mr. Liaquat Ali Shar, learned Additional Advocate General, Sindh, who is present in Court in connection with some other matters, waives notice of the instant petition and records his no objection to the proposal made by the learned counsel for the petitioners.

In view of the above, the Municipal Committee, Kandhkot, is directed to deal with and decide the matter concerning the petitioners strictly in accordance with law, the applicable rules and prescribed policies, without being influenced by the order dated 22.07.2026 passed by this Court in C.P. No.D-17 of 2026.

The instant petition is accordingly disposed of along with the listed applications.
